Monthly Meetings

Cruising / Fun Sailing

The Club host several cruises each year, from simply sailing from Hells Canyon Resort in Clarkston to Chief Timothy for summer meetings to an overnight full moon cruise to multiple day cruises down the Snake River to trips on Priest Lake, Lake Couer d'Alene and even the San Juan Islands.

During June, July and August, the Club also has the Wednesday Evening Fun Sails. This is a time to just go out and enjoy the evening, or if the wind does not cooperate, a time to hang out on the docks and enjoy the company of fellow sailors.

Racing

For those looking for a little competition, the Club host several racing opportunities each year, beginning with the Frostbite Series in February, March and April and ending with the Fall Series in October and November.

We also host two weekend long regattas each year - the Alex Bell in late April and the Annual Tribune Cup Regatta in mid September. Both of these events attract sailors from all over the Northwest.

In addition to these events, many members tow their boats to regattas on several regional lakes.

Racing dues are an additional \$25.00 which goes towards trophies and maintenance of race related equipment.
